

References for School Applications

Applies to references for all schools

Many applications are received and whilst most families are well known, some are difficult to identify. Even although the Priest in Charge, or others, may have seen and spoken to someone in church, we will not always know their name. Often it is not possible to be sure how frequently or for how long someone has attended church.

If you are thinking of applying for a school place, and may want a reference from the church, please discuss this with the Priest in Charge as soon as possible. Before you submit your application to the school, please complete the form overleaf and *hand it to the priest in charge after Sunday worship.*

For each school application we will

1. Check for a completed reply slip
2. Check for regular attendance in church by
 - a. Making sure the family are known by the Priest in Charge or one of the Lay Readers and/or
 - b. Looking for the name of the child in the registers of Little Mice, Crèche or KidzChurch as appropriate.
3. Check for membership of Meanwood uniformed organisation by contacting the appropriate leader.

We strongly recommend that parents consider becoming involved in some aspect of church life. This will both ensure that they are known and, more importantly, help them to build friendships and grow in their Christian faith.
